REGISTRATION AND PERMITS ARE NON-TRANSFERRABLE.

**I. APPLICANT INFORMATION (SECTIONS 119306, 119312 & 119325)** – Provide full name, mailing address, and contact information. Registrants must also identify the facility where they plan to provide body art services in Shasta.

**II. PROCEDURES TO BE PERFORMED (SECTION 119301)** - Body Art practitioner applicant should identify each service that will be provided. Body Art Facility owner applicant should identify all the services that will be provided within the facility.

Tattooing – means the insertion of pigment in human skin by piercing with a needle.

Body Piercing – means the creation of an opening in a human body for the purpose of inserting jewelry or other decoration. “Body piercing” includes, but is not limited to, the piercing of an ear, including the tragus, lip, tongue, nose, or eyebrow. “Body piercing” does not include the piercing of an ear, except for the tragus, with a disposable, single-use, pre-sterilized clasp and stud or solid needle that is applied using a mechanical device to force the needle or stud through the ear.

Permanent Cosmetics – means the application of pigments in human skin tissue for the purpose of permanently changing the color or appearance of the skin. This includes, but is not limited to, permanent eyeliner, eyebrow, or lip color.

Branding – means the process in which a mark or marks are burned into human skin tissue with a hot iron or other instrument, with the intention of leaving a permanent scar.

Mechanical Stud and Clasp Ear Piercing (Section 119325) – means the utility of a single use mechanical stud and clasp device for piercing the ear.

**III. FACILITY LOCATION (SECTIONS 119306, 119312 & 119325)** – All applicants must provide the business name, location address, and contact information in which body art and/or mechanical stud and clasp ear piercing procedures are to be performed. If a business has multiple locations, each site must be identified and permitted.

#### **IV. REQUIRED DOCUMENTS**

All body art practitioners in Shasta County must show proof of current bloodborne pathogen training. The training and training material must be specific to performing body art. The training shall consist of not less than two hours of instruction. And the training must meet the requirements of Title 8 of the California Code of Regulations (CalOSHA) or be California AB300 compliant.

**V. FEES (SECTION 119306)** – Payment of a registration fee shall be paid directly to the local enforcement agency.

Required registration, permit, or notification fees (sections 119306, 119312 & 119325) - Applications for registration, facility permit, or notification must include payment of appropriate fees. Please check the appropriate boxes and remit the required fees with your application.

Annual Body Art Practitioner Registration – Required for all individuals providing body art services.

Annual Body Art Facility Permit – Required for businesses where tattoo, body piercing, branding, and/or permanent cosmetic services are performed.

Mechanical Stud and Clasp Ear Piercing Notification – Required for facilities where mechanical stud and clasp devices are used for piercing the ear.
