



FAWN FIRE DEBRIS REMOVAL WARNING

At this time it is not known if there will be State or Federal assistance for the debris removal process. **PLEASE BE ADVISED that if you remove fire debris or disturb the ash footprint, you may be ineligible for any State or Federal debris removal assistance.** A State-facilitated debris removal program, if offered, could be of great benefit to those with or without insurance. In any event, **a Demolition Permit is required before removing fire debris;** a permit is not required to remove personal property.

CAUTION

ASH & DEBRIS MAY BE HOT AND CONTAIN HAZARDOUS MATERIALS. USE APPROPRIATE RESPIRATORY PROTECTION, GLOVES, DISPOSABLE COVERALLS, FOOTWARE, GOGGLES & HARDHAT.

DO NOT DISTURB ASH WITH LEAF BLOWERS. ASH SHOULD BE WETTED TO PREVENT AIRBORNE EMISSIONS, BUT SHOULD NOT BE SATURATED TO THE POINT OF RUNOFF.
