Encourages and immediately helps burned-out property owners remove fire debris waste from private property.	Single-family residence, mobile home or manufactured home that was at least 25% destroyed from those parcels identified on the Cal Fire DINS List.	First, consider that removal of fire debris or disturbing the ash footprint may cause ineligibility for state or federal debris removal assistance.
Waives the Demolition Permit Fee (up to \$122 per Demolition Permit) per parcel for disposal of fire damaged debris at the West Central Landfill.		Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) must conduct Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) removal on the property.
Provides vouchers of up to \$2,000 per parcel for disposal of fire damaged debris at the West Central Landfill.		Demolition Permit must be obtained.

Utility miscellaneous structure(s) that were at least 25% destroyed and over 120 sq. ft. from those parcels identified on the Cal Fire DINS List but did not lose a residence or home.	First, consider that removal of fire debris or disturbing the ash footprint may cause ineligibility for state or federal debris removal assistance.
Waives the Demolition Permit Fee (up to \$122 per Demolition Permit) per parcel for disposal of fire damaged debris at the West Central Landfill.		Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) must conduct Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) removal on the property.
Provides vouchers of up to \$160 per parcel for disposal of fire damaged debris at the West Central Landfill.		Demolition Permit must be obtained.
