CURRENT SITUATION

- We had 210 cases on Friday and Saturday, including 85 men and 125 women:
 - 6 children under age 13
 - 10 teenagers
 - 35 people in their 20s
 - 38 people in their 30s
 - 25 people in their 40s
 - 29 people in their 50s
 - 27 people in their 60s
 - 21 people in their 70s
 - 10 people in their 80s
 - 9 people over age 89
- We are sorry to report 2 deaths today. They are a woman in her 60s and a woman in her 70s.
- At this time, vaccination is available to people in Phase 1a, Tiers 1 and 2, and more groups will be added to the list as more vaccine is received.
