CURRENT SITUATION

- We had 104 cases Tuesday, including 59 men, 44 women and 1 person of unknown age and gender:
 - 7 children under age 13
 - 3 teenagers
 - 10 people in their 20s
 - 24 people in their 30s
 - 26 people in their 40s
 - 9 people in their 50s
 - 12 people in their 60s
 - 7 people in their 70s
 - 3 people in their 80s
 - 2 people over age 89
- We are sorry to have to report six deaths today. They are a man in his 60s, a woman in her 70s, two men in their 70s and two men in their 80s.
- This report includes a weekly update to our total case numbers, as we have been conducting case investigations to correct reported cases that were duplicates or out-of-county records.
- **Who is being vaccinated now?** People in [Phase 1A](#) (healthcare workers, long-term care facilities, workers in emergency services) and people 75 and older. **How can they sign up for vaccine?** Options are listed at www.ShastaReady.org (click "Vaccinations").
