CURRENT SITUATION

- We had 62 cases Tuesday, including 32 men, 29 women and one person of unknown age and gender:
 - 2 children under age 13
 - 8 teenagers
 - 9 people in their 20s
 - 9 people in their 30s
 - 13 people in their 40s
 - 7 people in their 50s
 - 7 people in their 60s
 - 4 people in their 70s
 - 2 people in their 80s
- We are sorry to report two deaths today. They were a woman in her 70s and a man in his 80s.
- This report includes a weekly update to our total case numbers, as we have been conducting case investigations to correct reported cases that were duplicates or out-of-county records.

- If you received your first COVID-19 shot during the mass vaccination clinic on January 16 in Redding, you can get your second dose Saturday, Feb. 13, at the Shasta District Fairgrounds in Anderson. This will be a drive-through clinic. Please arrive by last name:
 - **A-G**, 10-11:30 a.m.
 - **H-M**, 11:30-1 p.m.
 - **N-S**, 1-2:30 p.m.
 - **T-Z**, 2:30-4 p.m.

Your CDC card that shows the date of your first vaccine **is required**. Other second dose options will be available soon.
