CURRENT SITUATION	
Situation Summary:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> We have no new positive cases today. During this holiday weekend, we encourage people to enjoy the sunshine at home with their immediate families. Staying socially connected but physically distant will help us continue to keep our case numbers low. Shasta County Probation has taken the lead on complaints about non-compliant businesses. They are receiving around 40 complaints a day. They first call the business and follow up with face-to-face conversations to educate them about the State and Federal guidelines regarding social distancing, the Governor's stay-at-home order, and the difference between essential and non-essential functions during the shelter in place. If businesses are non-essential, they ask them to close. Nurses from local school districts, investigators from the Shasta County District Attorney's Office, and representatives from Shasta County Sheriff's Office, Redding Police Department, and Anderson Police Department have been trained to help with case investigation and contact tracing. This is another example of the community-wide collaboration that has been critical to this response.
