CURRENT SITUATION

Situation Summary:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> We have 1 new positive case today. The patient is a male in his 50s who is in isolation at home. Following the practices of the Centers for Disease Control and the California Department of Public Health, we are no longer reporting the number of recovered patients. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, Shasta County is looking to hire more people to work in the Alternate Care Site (formerly known as the Federal Medical Station) and other assignments. People who are experiencing symptoms of COVID-19 (fever, cough, shortness of breath) should contact their healthcare provider to be tested. Those who don't have a healthcare provider or are having trouble getting a test should call Shasta County Public Health at (530) 225-5591 so they can be screened and scheduled for mobile testing.
