| <b>Situation Summary:</b>   | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>We have no new positive cases today.</li> <li><b>Continue to avoid crowded spaces. Some area beaches and trails are open now, but we must use them safely.</b> We must still protect our vulnerable neighbors, including people age 65 and older or those with underlying medical conditions, and they should still remain at home as much as possible.</li> <li>California is reopening in stages to minimize the risk of spreading COVID-19. Shasta County is in Stage 2, which has allowed many lower-risk businesses to reopen with required modifications. Businesses that aren't yet allowed to open can lay the required groundwork now so they're ready to reopen as soon as it's OK. Business owners can begin building a reopening plan using the guidance and checklist at <a href="http://www.ShastaReady.org">www.ShastaReady.org</a> – click on “Roadmap to Recovery” and select “What Businesses Cannot Open Yet?” These recommendations are based on what is known right now.
