This guidance is at www.ShastaReady.org; click on “Roadmap to Recovery – Reopening Toolkit” and scroll to “What can open now?” • The state is expected to announce tomorrow that hair salons and barber shops will be allowed to open (with modifications) for haircuts in counties with variances, including Shasta County. Guidance will be posted on www.ShastaReady.org when it becomes available. • The state has also allowed opening of retail malls throughout California, but this was already allowed in Shasta County because of its variance. • Be a smart consumer!
