If you don’t have symptoms, go to https://lhi.care/covidtesting. Appointments are required. If you’re an employer, encourage your employees to get tested regularly. Please remember that non-essential travel is prohibited. Gatherings are still not allowed in California, except in places of worship and for the purposes of protest, with modifications. Feelings of stress and worry are a normal part of living through an infectious disease pandemic, like COVID-19.
