Situation Summary:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> We have one new case today: a man in his 60s who had no symptoms. Still wondering what is open? State public health directives still prohibit professional, social and community mass gatherings. Gatherings are defined as meetings or other events that bring together people from multiple households at the same time for a shared or group experience in a single room, space, or place such as an auditorium, stadium, arena, large conference room, meeting hall, or other indoor or outdoor space. They pose an especially high danger of transmission and spread of COVID-19. The exceptions are for faith-based services, cultural ceremonies and protests, and guidance for those activities is at www.ShastaReady.org. Now that people are spending more time in public, we encourage everyone to get tested for COVID-19. If you have symptoms, contact your healthcare provider or call Shasta County Public Health at (530) 225-5591. If you don't have symptoms, go to https://lhi.care/covidtesting. Appointments are required.
