The patient is a man in his 30s who had symptoms and is isolated at home.</li> <li>Many new businesses are now allowed to open due to newly released guidance. Find the press release at <a href="http://www.ShastaReady.org">www.ShastaReady.org</a> – click on “Current News.”</li> <li>People do not need to have symptoms of COVID-19 to spread the virus. Wearing face coverings in public, practicing social distancing, washing hands frequently and avoiding travel are some of the ways we can all help protect our vulnerable neighbors and slow the spread of COVID-19 in our community.</li> <li>Testing options are increasing in Shasta County. Testing for people with symptoms will now be available weekly in the Intermountain area, alternating between Burney and Fall River Mills. On Thursday, June 18, mobile testing will be in Burney, and the following Thursday, June 25, it will be in Fall River Mills. Make an appointment by calling (530) 225-5591.</li> <li>Anyone can be tested for COVID-19. If you have symptoms, contact your healthcare provider or call (530) 225-5591.
