<b>Situation Summary:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>We have four new cases today. They are two women in their 50s with no symptoms, a man in his 40s with symptoms, and a woman in her 30s with symptoms. None of the cases were connected with the family gathering reported earlier this week.</li> <li>The state of California has mandated that face coverings are now required state wide by the public when outside the home. The timing of the release of this guidance will help address the increase of COVID-19 in our county.
