CURRENT SITUATION

Situation Summary:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> We have five new cases today. Four had symptoms and none are hospitalized. They are a woman in her 20s, a man in his 30s, a woman in her 50s, a woman in her 60s, and a man in his 70s. Cal/OSHA is urging all employers in California to carefully review and follow the state's COVID-19 workplace safety and health guidance to ensure their workers are protected from the virus. The guidance will help employers comply with their obligations to implement effective measures to train and protect employees at each worksite. Complaints about workplace safety and health hazards can be filed confidentially with Cal/OSHA. Employees with work-related questions or complaints may call 844-522-6734. Anyone can be tested for COVID-19. People with or without symptoms can sign up for testing at Shasta College. Go to https://lhi.care/covidtesting. Appointments are required. If you have symptoms, contact your healthcare provider first. If you don't have a healthcare provider, call (530) 225-5591 to access mobile testing in Redding or the Intermountain area.
