<ul style="list-style-type: none"> We have 4 new cases today. Two had symptoms and none are hospitalized. They are a teenage boy, a woman in her 20s, a man in his 30s and a man in his 70s. Answers to common questions, including questions about schools, can be found on ShastaReady.org under the Frequently Asked Questions tab. Masks and hand sanitizer are being offered at no cost to businesses that employ 25 or fewer people. More than half a million state-allocated surgical masks and 4,286 gallons of hand sanitizer have been made available to Shasta County small businesses through the California Governor’s Office of Emergency Services (CalOES) in collaboration with the Governor’s Office of Business and Economic Development (GoBiz).
