<ul style="list-style-type: none"> We have 12 new cases today. 8 had symptoms and none are hospitalized. They are: A teenage boy older than 13 years, 3 men in their 20s, 2 women in their 20s, 2 men in their 30s, a man in his 50s, 2 women in their 50s, and a man in his 60s. We are still within the window of possible contraction of Covid-19 for those who recently attended a large outdoor gathering at the Sundial Bridge. Those who attended are urged to self-quarantine for 14 days from the event to protect others. They are also urged to consider being tested.
