Recipients must have 5 or fewer employees, be a for-profit business, be a brick-and-mortar business (including home-based) and have not received a Paycheck Protection Program (PPP) loan or SBA loan of \$5,000 or higher during the COVID-19 crisis, among other requirements. Shasta County and the Cities of Redding, Shasta Lake and Anderson partnered with the Redding Chamber of Commerce for this effort.
