They are: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Two girls under 13 A teenage boy A man in his 20s A man in his 60s Gov. Gavin Newsom has announced a new, four-tier system to determine what activities are allowable in counties (more information is available here). Shasta County is at “Moderate,” or an orange level, so the following activities are allowed with modifications starting Monday, Aug. 31: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Restaurants (dine-in): maximum 50% capacity or 200 people, whichever is fewer Places of worship: maximum 50% capacity or 200 people, whichever is fewer Museums: maximum 50% capacity Movie theaters: maximum 50% capacity or 200 people, whichever is fewer Family entertainment centers and indoor playgrounds, bowling alleys, climbing walls: maximum 25% capacity Gyms and fitness centers, including indoor pools: maximum 25% capacity Cardrooms: maximum 25% capacity Wineries: maximum 25% capacity or 100 people, whichever is fewer Brewpubs, breweries, bars, pubs and distilleries that don’t serve food: open outdoors only Anyone can be tested for COVID-19.
