- We had 2 new cases on Monday. Neither had symptoms and neither is hospitalized. They are:
 - A man in his 40s
 - A woman in her 70s
- Our total number of cases has been corrected to remove two patients who had been counted twice. They were a woman in her 40s and a man in his 20s.
