Twelve had symptoms, one is still under investigation and none are hospitalized. They are: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> A girl under 13 A man in his 20s Two women in their 30s Two women and one man in their 40s One man in his 50s Three women and one man in their 60s Three women and one man in their 80s Two women and one man over age 89 While one person can spread the virus to hundreds of others, the reverse is also true.
