CURRENT SITUATION	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> We had a total of 41 new cases on Friday and Saturday (no case work was done on Sunday). Twenty-five had symptoms (four are still unknown) and none are hospitalized. They are: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Two teenage girls and three teenage boys Eight women and three men in their 20s Six women and one man in their 30s One man in his 50s Three women and five men in their 60s Five women in their 70s Three women and one man in their 80s While all people should be using COVID precautions, some of us have a higher responsibility to be vigilant. If you work or live with people who are at higher risk (older adults or people with health conditions), please be extra-cautious. Some Shasta County residents who had to be hospitalized or died from COVID had not been out in public themselves, but were in contact with people who had been. Please wear face coverings, practice social distancing, wash hands frequently, avoid travel and gatherings, and stay home when you are sick, even if symptoms are mild. Anyone can be tested for COVID-19. Some same-day appointments are available for people with and without symptoms.
