CURRENT SITUATION

- We had 15 new cases on Monday. All had symptoms and one is hospitalized. They are:
 - One girl under 13
 - One teenage boy
 - Six men in their 20s
 - One woman and two men in their 30s
 - One woman in her 50s
 - One woman and one man in their 70s
 - One woman in her 80s
- We've seen an uptick of cases in recent days. As our local colleges and universities are resuming, some students are testing positive for COVID when they arrive. While there has been no transmission on a local college campus to date, there has been transmission in places where college students live together. There has also been an outbreak in a skilled nursing facility, with 34 residents and 8 staff testing positive since the outbreak started in late August. Shasta County Public Health and the State of California are working closely with that facility to stop transmission. It is critically important for people to wear face coverings, practice physical distancing, stay home when sick and wash hands frequently, especially when you live in close proximity to others or work with vulnerable people.
- Anyone can be tested for COVID-19. A high number of tests can help keep our positivity rate low, which keeps local industry open. Go to ShastaReady.org and click on "Get tested" to find out the best option for you.
