CURRENT SITUATION

- We had 33 new cases on Wednesday. Thirty had symptoms (one was unknown) and none are hospitalized. They are:
 - One boy under age 13
 - Three teenage girls and six teenage boys
 - Six women and six men in their 20s
 - Four women in their 30s
 - One woman and one man in their 40s
 - Four women in their 50s
 - One man in his 60s
- Wildfire smoke is in the air, flu season is beginning and COVID-19 continues to spread in our community. Exposure to any of these things can make people cough or sneeze. COVID-19 spreads through respiratory droplets, so if you have the virus and you are coughing or sneezing for any reason, you could spread COVID-19 to people around you. **If you feel sick, please stay home and away from others.**
