### CURRENT SITUATION

- We had 26 new cases on Tuesday, including 10 men and 16 women. They are:
  - 3 children under age 13
  - 2 teenagers
  - 5 people in their 20s
  - 1 person in their 30s
  - 4 people in their 40s
  - 1 person in their 50s
  - 3 people in their 60s
  - 4 people in their 80s
  - 3 people over age 89
- We are sorry to have to report three deaths today. The patients were two women in their 60s and one woman in her 80s.
