The patient was a man in his 80s. • The Shasta County Board of Supervisors will hold a special meeting tomorrow (October 22) at 9 a.m. to discuss what options may be available relating to the State’s Blueprint for a Safer Economy and the restrictions imposed through the statewide tier system. The Board will consider information regarding the local impact of the COVID-19 pandemic including economic, financial, and community health considerations and will direct a path forward. Public comment will be received before and during the meeting.
