



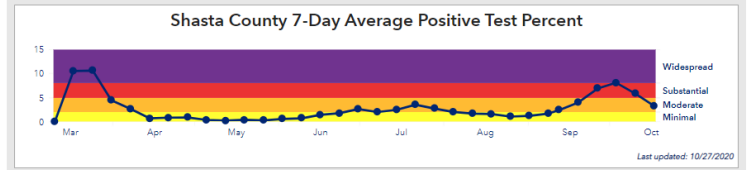
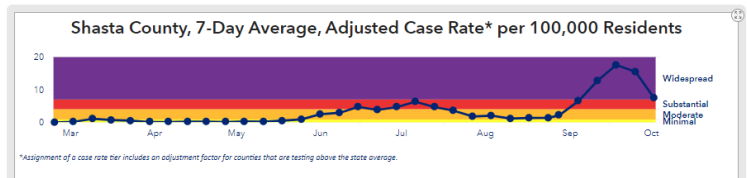
# COVID-19 INCIDENT UPDATE: October 27, 2020

Statistics from October 25 and 26, 2020

## CURRENT SITUATION

- We had a total of 73 new cases on Sunday and Monday, including 31 men and 42 women. The new cases are:
  - 4 children under age 13
  - 5 teenagers
  - 13 people in their 20s
  - 14 people in their 30s
  - 8 people in their 40s
  - 17 people in their 50s
  - 10 people in their 60s
  - 1 person in their 70s
  - 1 person in their 80s



- We are sorry to have to report a death today. The patient was a woman in her 70s.
- Shasta County will remain in the red (“substantial”) tier for at least another week. Our adjusted case rate decreased from 15.5 to 7.5 daily cases per 100,000 residents, which is just slightly higher than the purple tier limit of 7.0. Our positivity rate also decreased from 5.8% to 3.3%, which is in the orange (“moderate”) tier. Our [health equity quartile positivity rate](#) is 3.1%, which is also in the orange tier. These numbers are a seven-day average with a seven-day lag (Oct. 11-17).
- While our case rate still measures in the purple, [state guidance says](#) that during the weekly assessment, the California Department of Public Health reviews the most recent 10 days of data, and if there are objective signs of improvement, the county may remain in the less restrictive tier. This is why Shasta has been allowed to remain in the red tier for now.
