CURRENT SITUATION

- We had 178 cases on Thursday, including 84 men, 85 women and 9 people of unknown gender:
 - 16 children under age 13
 - 19 teenagers
 - 25 people in their 20s
 - 24 people in their 30s
 - 23 people in their 40s
 - 34 people in their 50s
 - 18 people in their 60s
 - 12 people in their 70s
 - 4 people in their 80s
 - 0 people over age 89
 - 3 people of unknown age
- The testing that has recently become available at the HHS offices in Anderson, Enterprise and Shasta Lake City is **by appointment only**. Testing is at the Enterprise office on Wednesday, Thursday and Friday; at the Anderson office on Saturday; and at the Shasta Lake City office on Sunday. This is state testing, and the people who conduct the tests are not there on other days, so please do not come to an office for a COVID-19 test without an appointment.
