### CURRENT SITUATION

- We had 225 cases on Wednesday through Saturday, including 89 men, 134 women and 2 people of unknown gender:
  - 8 children under age 13
  - 19 teenagers
  - 34 people in their 20s
  - 36 people in their 30s
  - 33 people in their 40s
  - 22 people in their 50s
  - 22 people in their 60s
  - 26 people in their 70s
  - 14 people in their 80s
  - 11 people over age 89
  - 0 people of unknown age
- There are four vaccination phases planned in Shasta County, and Phase 1 has 3 tiers (1a, 1b and 1c). Shasta County is in Phase 1a, Tier 1. This "jumpstart" phase offers the first vaccine doses to health care workers and residents of long-term care facilities. In Shasta County, there are nearly 14,000 health care workers. Health care workers are high priority because they risk being exposed to COVID-19 each day on the job and they sustain our medical services during this pandemic.
