CURRENT SITUATION

- We had 137 cases on Wednesday, including 49 men, 87 women and 1 person of unknown gender:
 - 3 children under age 13
 - 4 teenagers
 - 26 people in their 20s
 - 19 people in their 30s
 - 27 people in their 40s
 - 18 people in their 50s
 - 17 people in their 60s
 - 13 people in their 70s
 - 6 people in their 80s
 - 3 people over age 89
 - 1 person of unknown age
- We are sorry to report five deaths today. They are a woman in her 30s, a man in his 50s, two men in their 70s and a woman in her 80s.
- The state’s disease reporting system had an issue yesterday that caused data to be incomplete. Today’s total number is a readjustment, as some cases were not included in yesterday’s count.
