CURRENT SITUATION

- We had 31 cases Tuesday, including 11 men and 20 women:
 - 1 child under 13
 - 8 teenagers
 - 2 people in their 20s
 - 3 people in their 30s
 - 6 people in their 40s
 - 4 people in their 50s
 - 3 people in their 60s
 - 1 people in their 70s
 - 2 people in their 80s
 - 1 person over age 89
- This report includes a weekly update to our total case numbers, as we have been conducting case investigations to correct reported cases that were duplicates or out-of-county records.
- **SECOND DOSE CLINICS:** The following second-dose clinics are scheduled this week:
 - March 4: For those who received Pfizer on Feb. 12 at Shasta College
 - March 5: For those who received Moderna on Feb. 5 at Shasta College
 - March 6: For those who received Moderna on Feb. 6 at Shasta College
 - March 6: For school staff who received Pfizer on Feb. 13 at Vibra

- **Question:** I am an essential worker. Can I be vaccinated now? **Answer:** It depends. Healthcare workers, staff and residents of skilled/assisted living facilities, staff of substance use treatment centers, community health workers, public health staff with patient contact, lab workers, pharmacy staff, mortuary workers, school staff, child care workers and emergency services workers are among those who are eligible now. Food and agriculture workers are now eligible and clinics are being scheduled for them. Other essential workers need to wait until their age group is eligible.
