### CURRENT SITUATION

- We had 33 cases Friday and Saturday, including 16 men, 16 women and 1 person of unknown gender:
  - 3 children under 13
  - 4 teenagers
  - 6 people in their 20s
  - 3 people in their 30s
  - 6 people in their 40s
  - 3 people in their 50s
  - 5 people in their 60s
  - 3 people in their 70s
- We are sorry to have to report two deaths today. They are a man in his 70s and a woman over the age of 89.
