CURRENT SITUATION

- We had 12 cases Wednesday, including 5 men and 7 women:
 - 1 teenager
 - 2 people in their 20s
 - 2 people in their 30s
 - 3 people in their 40s
 - 2 people in their 60s
 - 1 person in their 70s
 - 1 person over age 89

Here are some people who qualify NOW: People who work in restaurants, pharmacies, grocery stores, convenience stores, pet stores, take-out and delivery, farmers, janitors, educators, veterinarians, healthcare workers, animal control, security staff, emergency workers, and people who support any of those businesses - as long as you're over 16 (with parent consent), even if you're perfectly healthy. - The food and agriculture sector, which is [eligible for vaccine now](#), includes:
 - Workers at stores that sell food, beverages or animal or pet food
 - Restaurant workers and food delivery workers
 - Workers who manufacturer and supply food
 - Farmers, and farm and ranch workers, and workers in food, feed and beverage distribution
 - Workers who sanitize food equipment
 - Workers who grow and distribute plants for home gardens [nursery workers]
 - Workers in cafeterias
 - Workers needed for government assistance and payment programs
 - Workers in production, storage, transportation and distribution of chemicals and medicines used for food and agriculture
 - Animal agriculture workers
 - Veterinary health workers, and workers at animal care facilities
 - Workers who support sawmills [including people who work in stores selling lumber]
 - Workers who transport animals for animal agriculture
 - Workers who manufacture and maintain agricultural equipment [mechanics]
 - Cannabis industry employees
