CURRENT SITUATION

- We had 13 cases Thursday, including 5 men and 8 women:
 - 1 child under age 13
 - 1 teenager
 - 2 people in their 20s
 - 3 people in their 30s
 - 2 people in their 40s
 - 1 person in their 50s
 - 1 person in their 70s
 - 1 person in their 80s
 - 1 person over age 89
- We are sorry to report a death today. He was a man in his 50s.
- Vaccination is free and open to all. If you live or work in California, and you're 16 or older, it's your right to get vaccinated. Once you're fully protected, which is about two weeks after your final shot, there are many new things you can do safely:
 - You can visit with other fully-vaccinated people indoors without masks or distancing.
 - You can visit with unvaccinated people indoors without masks or distancing, if they are from a single household and are at low risk for getting very sick from COVID-19.
 - You can skip quarantining and testing if you are exposed to someone with COVID-19 and get no symptoms yourself.
