CURRENT SITUATION

- We had 22 cases Thursday, including 11 men and 11 women:
 - 1 child under age 13
 - 2 teenagers
 - 4 people in their 20s
 - 2 people in their 30s
 - 6 people in their 40s
 - 6 people in their 50s
 - 1 person in their 60s
- We are sorry to report a death today. He was a man in his 40s.
- Calling all men! Don't wait to get your COVID vaccine. Here in Shasta County, men are 1.58 times more likely to die from COVID-19 than women. At the same time, local data shows that of all the COVID-19 vaccines administered here, only 47% have been to men.
