



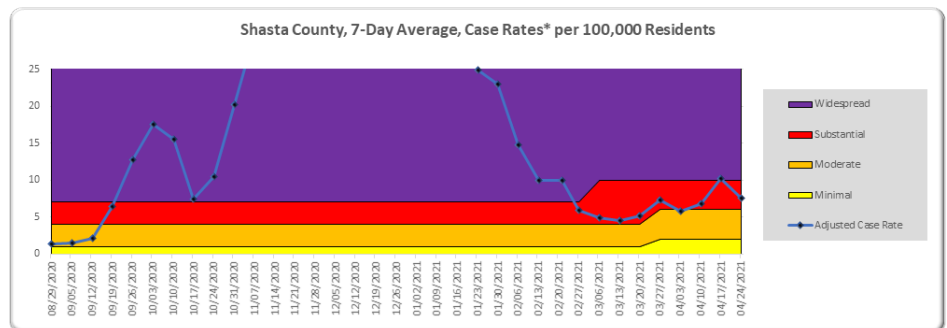
COVID-19 INCIDENT UPDATE: May 4, 2021

CURRENT SITUATION

- We had 58 cases Sunday and Monday, including 22 men and 36 women:
 - 6 children under age 13
 - 3 teenagers
 - 16 people in their 20s
 - 16 people in their 30s
 - 6 people in their 40s
 - 3 people in their 50s
 - 5 people in their 60s
 - 1 person in their 70s
 - 1 person in their 80s
 - 1 person of unknown age



- We are sorry to report 4 deaths today. They were a woman in her 70s and three women over age 89.
- Shasta County remains in the red (“substantial”) tier, but our numbers have improved. Our adjusted case rate decreased from 10.2 to 7.5 daily cases per 100,000 residents, and our positivity rate decreased from 3.9% to 2.7%. As a reminder, the upward slope in the red, orange and yellow tiers reflects when the state changed those tier thresholds due to increased vaccination in California.
- People who received their first dose of Pfizer on or before April 16 (including at the Shasta College clinic) are invited to a second-dose clinic on May 7 at Shasta College. People can walk in between 7:45 a.m. and 4 p.m. Please bring your CDC card. This clinic is for **second doses only**, but many first-dose appointments for Moderna, Pfizer and Johnson & Johnson are available through www.ShastaReady.org. Click on “Vaccinations.”
