CURRENT SITUATION

- We had 41 cases Tuesday, including 17 men, 23 women and 1 person of unknown gender:
 - 1 child under age 13
 - 5 teenagers
 - 10 people in their 20s
 - 9 people in their 30s
 - 7 people in their 40s
 - 2 people in their 50s
 - 5 people in their 60s
 - 1 person in their 70s
 - 1 person in their 80s
- This report includes a weekly update to our total case numbers, as we have been conducting case investigations to correct reported cases that were duplicates or out-of-county records.
- The Johnson & Johnson and Moderna vaccines will be available at a clinic Saturday, May 15, in Happy Valley. If you wish to be vaccinated, you can sign up at myturn.ca.gov, or you can drop by Happy Valley Elementary School, 17480 Palm Ave. in Anderson, between 10 a.m. and 4 p.m. Saturday.
