### CURRENT SITUATION

- We had 33 cases Friday and Saturday, including 15 men and 18 women:
  - 2 children under age 13
  - 4 teenagers
  - 6 people in their 20s
  - 5 people in their 30s
  - 5 people in their 40s
  - 4 people in their 50s
  - 4 people in their 60s
  - 1 person in their 70s
  - 1 person in their 80s
  - 1 person of unknown age
- Youth aged 12 to 15 can still receive the COVID-19 vaccine even if they have underlying health conditions. If you have specific questions about a condition, please talk to your healthcare provider or local community clinic.
- The State of California has decided to keep their current [masking guidance](#) without updating masking rules to the current CDC suggestions. On June 15, 2021, California will be moving “Beyond the Blueprint” and will implement the CDC’s guidance at that time. Until then, they will continue to prioritize interrupting transmission in high-risk indoor settings to protect workers, unvaccinated children, and immunocompromised persons, as well as continuing to vaccinate all eligible persons, especially in low-income communities.
- Starting Friday, May 21 at 3 p.m., Pfizer vaccine clinics will be held at the Redding Senior Center at 2290 Benton Drive, Redding. Walk-ins are welcome, or people can sign up for an appointment on [MyTurn.ca.gov](https://www.myturn.ca.gov). The Senior Center will be open Friday through Tuesday from 10 a.m. to 7 p.m. They will close for lunch from 2 – 3 p.m. They will also be closed on May 31 for Memorial Day.
