CURRENT SITUATION

- We had 37 cases Wednesday, including 19 men and 18 women:
 - 1 child under age 13
 - 2 teenagers
 - 12 people in their 20s
 - 7 people in their 30s
 - 5 people in their 40s
 - 7 people in their 50s
 - 1 person in their 60s
 - 1 person in their 70s
 - 1 person over age 89
- Starting tomorrow (Friday) at 3 p.m., Pfizer vaccine clinics will be available to ages 12 and up at the Redding Senior Center at 2290 Benton Drive, Redding. Walk-ins are welcome, or people can sign up for an appointment on www.MyTurn.ca.gov. The Senior Center will be open Friday through Tuesday from 10 a.m. to 7 p.m. They will close for lunch from 2 to 3 p.m. They will also be closed May 31 for Memorial Day.
- Shasta and Del Norte are the only counties in far Northern California that are still in the red tier due to high case rates. All but 10 counties statewide have moved into the orange or yellow tiers. High case rates mean that unvaccinated people are at very high risk of contracting COVID-19. Please get vaccinated, wear your mask in public indoor spaces, keep your distance and stay home when sick until more of our population is protected.
