CURRENT SITUATION

- We had 4 cases Thursday, including 3 men and 1 woman:
 - 2 children under age 13
 - 1 person in their 30s
 - 1 person in their 50s
- We are sorry to report a death today. The person was a man in his 80s.
- California is rolling out the nation’s biggest incentive program to encourage people to get their COVID-19 vaccine. People who get vaccinated can receive a \$50 gift card, and everyone who has been vaccinated already is eligible to win cash prizes. The “Vax for the Win” program is designed to boost vaccinations and help safely reopen the economy on June 15. Learn more at covid19.ca.gov/vax-for-the-win.
- **Question:** How many fully vaccinated people have still gotten COVID-19? **Answer:** In Shasta County, there have been 69 “breakthrough” cases, or about 0.14% of those who are fully vaccinated. Of those, 24 have had symptoms, 2 have been hospitalized and none have died, which underscores that the vaccine reduces the likelihood of severe illness and death for those who still become infected despite the vaccine’s effectiveness of more than 90 percent. None of the breakthrough cases tested positive for a variant.
- A clinic in Lakehead is planned tomorrow, May 29, from 11 a.m. to 3 p.m. This is a second-dose clinic for anyone who received their first dose of Moderna on or before May 1. The Johnson & Johnson one-dose shot will also be available. You can schedule an appointment at www.myturn.ca.gov or just walk in.
- A drive-through clinic is planned Wednesday, June 9, at Shasta County Public Health, 2650 Breslauer Way in Redding. This is a second-dose clinic for anyone who received their first dose of Pfizer on or before May 19, and the Johnson & Johnson one-dose shot will also be available. You can schedule an appointment at www.myturn.ca.gov or just drive up.
- Due to the Memorial Day holiday on Monday, May 31, county offices will be closed, as will the state’s testing site at Shasta College and the vaccination site at the Redding Senior Center. Our next daily incident update will be issued Tuesday, June 1.
