CURRENT SITUATION

- We had 24 cases Tuesday, including 12 men and 12 women:
 - 3 teenagers
 - 4 people in their 20s
 - 6 people in their 30s
 - 1 person in their 40s
 - 4 people in their 50s
 - 2 people in their 60s
 - 2 people in their 70s
 - 2 people in their 80s
- This report includes a weekly update to our total case numbers, as we have been conducting case investigations to correct reported cases that were duplicates or out-of-county records.
- A drive-through clinic is planned from 6 to 8:30 p.m. Wednesday, June 9, at Shasta County Public Health, 2650 Breslauer Way in Redding. This is a second-dose clinic for anyone who received their first dose of Pfizer on or before May 19, and the Johnson & Johnson one-dose shot will also be available. You can schedule an appointment at www.myturn.ca.gov or just drive up.
- Vaccines are free, safe and you can just walk in to get one. If you've been meaning to get your teenagers vaccinated but it's too overwhelming to figure out when you can fit appointments in between school, activities and jobs, there's a simple solution. If your children are 12 or older, you can bring them all down to the Pfizer clinic at Redding Senior Center between 10 a.m. and 7 p.m. Friday through Tuesday (closed from 2 to 3). You can also make an appointment if you prefer – just go to www.myturn.ca.gov and pick your times. This is just one of dozens of locations that offer vaccine.
