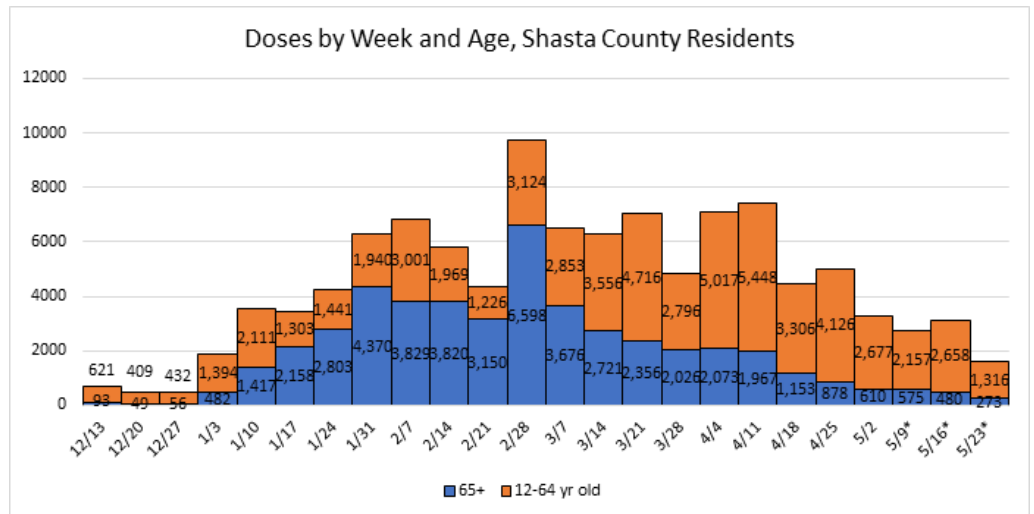

CURRENT SITUATION

- We had 26 cases Wednesday, including 14 men, 11 women and 1 person of unknown gender:
 - 4 people in their 20s
 - 6 people in their 30s
 - 2 people in their 40s
 - 6 people in their 50s
 - 3 people in their 60s
 - 4 people in their 70s
 - 1 person in their 80s

- A total of 107,214 vaccines have been given to Shasta County residents; 63,341 people have received at least one dose, and 48,758 are fully vaccinated. Of those, 71 people (less than 1 percent) have tested positive for COVID-19, including 24 who have had symptoms, 2 who have been hospitalized, and none who have died.



- An evening drive-through clinic is planned from 6 p.m. to 8:30 p.m. Wednesday, June 9, at Shasta County Public Health, 2650 Breslauer Way in Redding. This is a second-dose clinic for anyone who received their first dose of Pfizer on or before May 19, and the Johnson & Johnson one-dose shot will also be available.
