CURRENT SITUATION

- We had 21 cases Thursday, including 6 men and 15 women:
 - 2 teenagers
 - 3 people in their 20s
 - 5 people in their 30s
 - 4 people in their 40s
 - 1 person in their 50s
 - 4 people in their 60s
 - 1 person in their 70s
 - 1 person in their 80s
- Vaccines are free, safe and you can just walk in to get one. Anyone 12 and older can come to the Pfizer clinic at Redding Senior Center, 2290 Benton Drive, between 10 a.m. and 7 p.m. Friday through Tuesday (closed from 2 to 3). Walk-ins are always welcome, or make an appointment at www.myturn.ca.gov.
- All Californians who are at least partially vaccinated are automatically eligible for cash prize drawings taking place in June. The first of 30 winners of the "\$50,000 Fridays" cash prizes were drawn today, and on June 15, 10 winners will be selected to win \$1.5 million each. Also, the first two million Californians to start and complete their COVID-19 vaccination on or after May 27 will receive a \$50 gift card. For more information, visit covid19.ca.gov/vax-for-the-win.
- There's an easy way to throw your hat in the ring for one of those cash prizes, and that's through the evening drive-through clinic planned from 6 p.m. to 8:30 p.m. Wednesday, June 9, at Shasta County Public Health, 2650 Breslauer Way in Redding. This is a second-dose clinic for anyone who received their first dose of Pfizer on or before May 19, and the Johnson & Johnson one-dose shot will also be available.
