CURRENT SITUATION

- We had 32 cases Sunday and Monday, including 12 men and 20 women:
 - 1 child under age 13
 - 2 teenagers
 - 7 people in their 20s
 - 6 people in their 30s
 - 1 person in their 40s
 - 5 people in their 50s
 - 5 people in their 60s
 - 5 people in their 70s
- Upcoming free vaccine clinics:
 - **Pfizer:** Every Friday through Tuesday, 10 a.m. to 7 p.m. (closed from 2 to 3 p.m.), Redding Senior Center, 2290 Benton Drive. Walk in or make an appointment at www.myturn.ca.gov.
 - **Pfizer and Johnson & Johnson:** Drive-through clinic, 6 p.m. to 8:30 p.m. Wednesday, June 9, at Shasta County Public Health, 2650 Breslauer Way in Redding. Second-dose clinic for anyone who received their first dose of Pfizer on or before May 19. Johnson & Johnson one-dose also available. Drive up or make an appointment at www.myturn.ca.gov.

- Shasta County remains in the red ("substantial") tier in the final week before California moves Beyond the Blueprint, but both measurements improved this week. Our adjusted case rate decreased from 6.3 to 5.1 daily cases per 100,000 residents, and our positivity rate decreased from 2.9% to 2.7%.
