Businesses begin reopening as Stage 2 rolls out

Businesses have started reopening as Shasta County has moved into Stage 2 of the state's four-stage Resiliency Roadmap. These are the businesses that can open:

Roadmap to Recovery Stage 2 of 4

Businesses allowed to open (effective 5/12/2020 with modifications)

Retail businesses
Shopping malls
Dine-in restaurants
Car washes
Pet grooming
Tanning facilities
Office-based businesses
Outdoor museums and galleries
Childcare facilities

Businesses not allowed to open yet

Nail/Hair salons
Tattoo parlors
Gyms and fitness studios
Bars, lounges and night clubs
Movie theaters, state gaming facilities
Indoor museums, libraries
Community centers, pools, playgrounds
Religious services
Concert venues, festivals

Business owners can visit www.ShastaReady.org and click "Reopening Toolkit" to find guidance and checklists for reopening. These tools walk them through the process of ensuring a safe environment for staff and customers. These checklists can also be shared with staff and made available to customers upon request.

Opening these businesses with modifications was the first big step toward our community's recovery, and Shasta is one of 21 counties that have been allowed to move fully through Stage 2 so far. No California counties have been allowed to open beyond this point, and they cannot until the governor further changes his statewide order. Out-of-county travel and gatherings are also not permitted in California under Stage 2.

This staged plan is necessary to continue to limit the spread of COVID-19 and relies fully on the engagement and cooperation of individuals and businesses. Visit www.ShastaReady.org for more information.
