
Uniform Regulations

1000.1 PURPOSE AND SCOPE

The uniform policy of the Shasta County Sheriff's Office is established to ensure that uniformed deputies will be readily identifiable to the public through the proper use and wearing of department uniforms. Employees should also refer to the following associated Main SD Policy Manual sections and uniform manual for specifics:

Section 700 - Department Owned and Personal Property

Section 1023 - Body Armor

Refer to the Shasta County main policy manual for specific uniform regulations.

010 CORRECTIONS.

- A. Hats [optional while on transport or range] (020 C or E).
- B. Jackets [optional] (021 B & C).
- C. Sweater [optional] (022 A or B).
- D. Shirts (023 A or B 1&2) Custody Officers may have embroidered star and name tag.
- E. T-Shirt (024).
- F. Trousers (25 A 1 & 2).
- G. Socks (26).
- H. Footwear (27 A or B).
- I. Prescribed equipment (037 B 2).
- J. Eyeglass Retainer [optional] (048) D.A.R.E. Officers are exempt from the equipment requirement (037) while performing their duties with the provision that the equipment be available in their vehicle.
- K. Name tag (029).

020 SPECIAL DUTY. A Special Duty uniform is authorized to be worn for the performance of duty assignments as follows: S.W.A.T., C.E.R.T., Bomb Squad, Marijuana Eradication Team, Hostage Negotiations Team, and under certain circumstances, Narcotics operations.

- A. Hats (SWAT and MET olive drab "boonie cap").
- B. Shirts (SWAT, MET, and Bomb Squad 023 D 1; CERT & HNT 023 D 2).
- C. Trousers (SWAT, MET, and Bomb Squad 25 C 1; CERT & HNT 25 C 2).

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- D. Socks (26)
- E. Footwear (26 A or B, MET footwear is optional depending on terrain).
- E. Name tag (029 A. 3.).
- F. Equipment will vary depending on assignment (See respective specialty unit manual for details).

030 JUMPSUITS.

The following utility jumpsuit is approved as optional wear: California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation approved green jumpsuit, 7.5 oz. per square inch yard squad cloth, 65% polyester, 35% cotton blend in Twill for cooler weather, and 5.8 oz., 65% polyester and 35% cotton blend in Poplin for warmer weather. When authorized by Division Commander, utility jumpsuits may have the sleeves tailored short to an appropriate short sleeve length. Shoulder epaulet is optional. (Refer to section 029 C for specifications on name tag to be utilized on the jumpsuit and 210 C for specifications on badge to be utilized on the jumpsuit.) The jumpsuits are optional, are to be purchased by the employee, and may be worn by the following:

Correctional Officers and deputies who are assigned to the Custody Division working in the Shasta County Main Jail, with approval of the Division Commander, as authorized by the department. Custody sergeants are not authorized to wear the jumpsuit.

The Sheriff's Office will provide the departmental shoulder patches and rockers as warranted. The jumpsuits are made to order and members must be measured to assure a proper fit. The shoulder patches (and rockers and chevrons if applicable) should be sent at the time of order so the manufacturer can properly sew them on the waterproof fabric.

The jumpsuit shall be worn in conjunction with an authorized t-shirt, a black turtleneck sweater or black dickey. When the jumpsuit is worn, the 5.11 Tactical Series 4-in-1 Patrol Jacket #48027, black (085 B) may be worn as an outer garment.

040 SHERIFF'S SERVICE OFFICER FACILITY UNIFORM.

The Sheriff's Service Officer shall possess and maintain, ready for immediate use, the following specified uniform:

- A. Jacket [Optional utility] (021 C).
- B. Shirts (023 A or B 1 & 2).
- C. T-shirt (024).
- D. Trousers (025 3).
- E. Socks (026).
- F. Footwear (027 A or B).
- G. Prescribed equipment (037 B 2 a & c-g).
- H. The Sheriff's Service Officer rocker shall be worn under the department shoulder patch.
- I. Name tag (029).

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050 FOOD SERVICE EMPLOYEES.

Food service employees (Cook II) shall possess and maintain, ready for immediate use, the following specified uniform:

- A. Hat (020 D).
- B. Shirts (023 B/3).
- C. T-shirt (024).
- D. Trousers (25A 4).
- E. Socks (026).
- F. Footwear (027).
- G. Name tag (029 A).
- H. Shoulder patches (031).
- I. Belt (1038/B).
- J. Key holder (Department issued).
- K. The Food Service rocker shall be worn under the department shoulder patch.

060 HATS

- A. WINTER: Forest Green trooper style, green flaps and tie down (optional for inclement weather).
- B. DRESS and FIELD: Campaign, Stratton, conservation green, double brim, SDB-40 straw, three piece strap, with gold cord/gold acorns.
- C. FOOD SERVICE EMPLOYEES: Furnished by the department and worn at all times while on the work site. The hat shall not be worn while off duty.
- D. UTILITY: Black baseball style cap with embroidered star as approved by department, or a black knit "beanie" cap with "SHERIFF" embroidered on the front. The caps shall have no other insignias, specialty pins, or marks on it. Cap and "beanie" caps are not to be worn off duty. Black "beanie" cap to be worn only in extreme cold conditions. The authorized field uniform caps are as follows: a black A-Flex or Richardson (or similar style) with gold color embroidered star; A black knit "Beanie" style cap with "SHERIFF" with gold embroidered letters 1 inch high, block style font.

070 JACKETS.

- A. The C.H.P. Eisenhower style jacket; forest green with light gold piping on each sleeve three inches above the cuff, seam to seam.
- B. 5.11 Tactical Series 4-in-1 Patrol Jacket #48027, black (019), with a black tactical zip-up patrol inner fleece jacket. The inner fleece jacket may be worn on duty independently from the outer jacket providing shoulder patches; Sheriff's badge patch and cloth name tag are sewn on. Authorized markings: Sheriff's Office patches sewn on both shoulders for outer and inner fleece jacket. Service Officer rockers shall be sewn below both patches, if appropriate. The outer jacket shall have a cloth badge patch and gold embroidered name tag (120 B). The inner fleece jacket shall have a Sheriff's badge patch with shoulder patches and a black cloth name tag with gold

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embroidered letters one-half (1/2) inch high, block style font.

C. Jacket: 5.11 Tactical zip-up Patrol Fleece Jacket #48038, black (019). The below listed jacket will be issued to Service Officers and Corrections Officers. Uniformed deputies may purchase the jacket for duty use. Authorized markings: Gold embroidered star on left chest, Sheriff's Office patches sewn on both shoulders. Service Officer rockers shall be sewn below both patches, if appropriate. Name tags (120A. 3.). Note: Jackets come from the supplier with the embroidered star only. Shoulder patches will need to be sewn on locally.

D. Firearms Instructors are authorized to wear black denim Carhartt jackets (R/N #14806) during inclement weather. The jacket will have an embroidered Sheriff's badge on the left chest and "Firearms Instructor" embroidered in bold red 2 inch high letters on the back, block style font.

080 OPTIONAL SWEATERS.

A. Blauer Commando V-neck sweater (or equivalent); forest green, 100% wool with badge, and nametag pads. The sweater tail is to be worn in a manner so as not to interfere when worn with safety equipment; i.e., tucked into trousers or folded under it's self. Rank insignias are to be worn by sergeants and above, centered on the epaulets.

B. Broadway Knitting cardigan (or equivalent), forest green, 100% acrylic nylon. This sweater is not to be equipped with department patches, as supplied by the department. (For general members only).

C. Turtle neck or mock turtleneck (optional). Black in color. Shall be worn only with the long sleeve uniform. SCSO insignia is only authorized marking on turtleneck (brand names or other insignias are unauthorized).

090 SHIRTS. C.H.P. certified silver tan #193, or 5.11 Tactical Series silver tan #160.

A. FIELD AND DRESS.

1. 5.11 Tactical Series PDU (5.11 specified class A or class B twill), or similar brand in Silver tan.
2. Flying Cross Poplin, Grey, #65R5441 (Food Services only).

B. UTILITY C.H.P. approved silver tan name shall be embroidered one-half (1/2) inch above the right side front pocket of the authorized utility shirt. (095 B). Embroidery shall be done with light gold Robinson Anton thread 22/42 (or equivalent). Letters shall three-quarter (3/4) inch high, block style font.

C. POLO SHIRT.

1. Cornerstone CS410 or CS411 (women) Select Snag Proof Tactical Polo, Tan, with embroidered star on left side and embroidered name on right side. (120 B). Authorized Personnel may have no more than two lines of embroidery to include name, rank, and a unit designation or division.
2. Elbeco K5102 tan polo shirt with a gold Sheriff's star embroidered on left chest and Sheriff's patches on both shoulders. The name shall be embroidered on the right chest for full time employees (120 B). This shirt is authorized for Boating Safety Unit personnel only.

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3. Cornerstone CS410 or CS411 (women) Select Snag Proof Tactical Polo, red, with gold Sheriff's Star embroidered on left chest and "Firearms Instructor" embroidered in black letters, one-half (1/2) inch high, block style font, directly underneath the Sheriff's Star. The Firearms Instructor may option to have his/her name embroidered on the right chest in black letters, block style font (120 A.1.).

4. Cornerstone CS410 or CS411 (women) Select Snag Proof Tactical Polo, black, with a gold Sheriff's Star embroidered on left chest, authorized for special duty only. The employee may option to have his/her name embroidered on the right chest (120 B).

D. 5.11 Tactical PDU, TDU or BDU style 2 or 4 pocket shirts.

1. Olive Drab (130).

2. Black (130).

100 T-SHIRT. A plain white or black, crew neck style T-shirt shall be worn by all members when wearing the dress, field, utility, or Food Services uniform.

011 TROUSERS.

A. Dress and Field.

1. L.A.S.D. approved.

2. BDU style, Black

3. SSO (brown), as supplied and authorized by the dept.

4. BDUP Button F, Black, #9500 (food services only).

B. Utility.

1. 5.11 Tactical Series PDU pants or similar style, Sheriff Green (890).

2. Animal Regulation, as supplied and authorized by the dept.

3. SSO (brown), as supplied and authorized by the dept.

4. O.E.S. issued Nomex pants (To be worn during fire duty or related training).

5. Shorts (optional apparel for personnel assigned to Boating Safety) as supplied by the dept.

6. Foul weather trousers, O.D. green, as supplied by the dept.

C. Special Duty.

1. 5.11 Tactical Series PDU or TDU style pants, O.D./TDU Green (182/190); Black (019); Khaki/TDU Khaki (055/162).
